We're excited to roll out the new Flyballscore app! Available now in the Apple Store, and coming soon to the Google Play Store. Until then, visit www.flyballscore.com in your browser and be sure to log in.

With Flyballscore you'll have real-time racing schedules, ring assignments, results and standings, and live-stream access to every ring. Just open the app or site, tap the Home icon, and select your ring color.

Crating & Set Up

- No set up before 2:00 pm on Thursday.
- Crating is assigned in both the Exhibition Hall and Gateway Hall (layout attached)
- Clubs who are crating in the Exhibition Hall must bring plastic to cover floors before setting up.
- Power is provided; bring extension cords just in case.

Schedules & Lineups

- Team captains will complete and submit lineups online through Flyballscore.
- Lineups must be filled out at least 30 minutes prior to the start of racing each day.

Scoring of Dog Titles

A draft view of the scoring of dog points earned will be calculated as racing occurs by flyballscore.com. The final points earned will be determined by U-FLI scoring after the event. Any pins or bars earned will be mailed to the captains of participating teams after the event. Please double check all RUN numbers on your timesheets to ensure that points are scored correctly.

Competition & Awards

- Racing begins daily at 8:00 am in the climate-controlled Exhibition Hall with padded flooring.
- One schedule will run across two rings Friday, then three rings on Saturday and Sunday.
- Awards follow racing each day.
